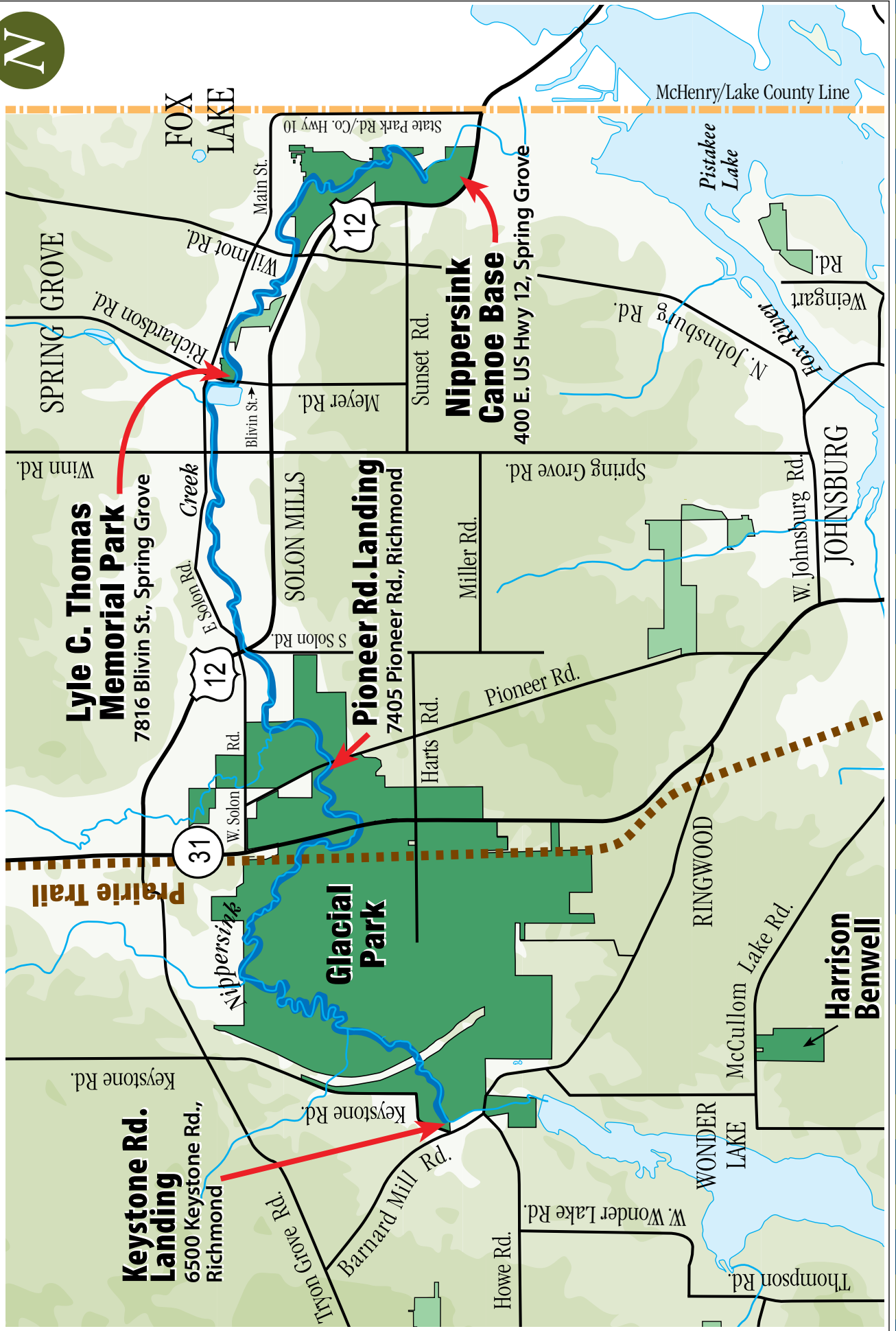

Keystone Road Landing to Pioneer Road Landing 2½–4 hours (6.7 M)

Pioneer Road Landing to Lyle C. Thomas Memorial Park . . . 2 hours (4.42 M)

Lyle C. Thomas Memorial Park to Nippersink Canoe Base . . . 2 hours (4.36 M)

RULES

- If the water is high, watch for submerged logs. Also watch for cross fences and submerged wires between Pioneer Rd. Landing and Lyle C. Thomas Memorial Park; lift them with wooden paddles in case they are electrified. Please report any downed trees to the District office at (815) 338-6223.
